RACISM IS REAL



Are white and black people treated equally in society?

JOB / WORK

When seeing a name associated with a black person on a resume employers are 50% less likely to respond.

POLICING

Black drivers are 2x as likely to get pulled over. Blacks face higher risks of police brutality and use of force.

STORES / PRICES

Blacks are offered higher prices and worse contracts when sold goods. Blacks often face discrimination when shopping in stores.

DRUGS

Blacks are 4x more likely to be arrested for drug use despite drug use being the same as other ethnic groups.

PRISONS / JAIL

Blacks are incarcerated at a rate of 6x that of whites. Prisons in the US are filled with blacks despite only being only 13.4% of the population.

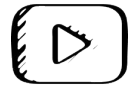
Discussing Racism
