11. How is our attention drawn to particular images? How are particular visual elements used as symbols or metaphors?
12. How does the film's editing contribute to the meaning of the film?
13. How does the film handle the underlying themes (morality, politics, religion, sexuality, happiness, freedom, love, spirituality, identity, etc.)?
14. Are there are religious themes or connections? How is faith treated (if at all)?

16. What is the view of humanity? What does the film say about the nature of human beings? What does the film say about communities and families?

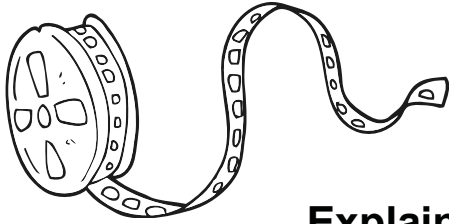
17. How is the image of God within human beings seen in this film? How is human rebellion against God expressed?
