

Fun v Funny

FUN

Noun – A source of enjoyment, amusement, or pleasure (placer / diversión).

Adjective – amusing or enjoyable (divertido).

Examples:

You use "fun" when you are describing something you did or will do. Fun is something entertaining that may **not** evoke laughter.

1. Swimming is fun.
2. Going to the movies sounds fun.
3. "We had fun" means "we enjoyed ourselves".

FUNNY

Adjective – Causing amusement or laughter (gracioso)

Adjective – Strange, rare, unusual (raro / curioso)

Examples:

You use "funny" when you find something amusing or it can be used to describe something unusual. Funny is something either humorous or peculiar

1. I find that joke funny. (Humorous)
2. Who is that guy? He looks a bit funny. (Strange)

Remember the expression:

“Funny ‘ha ha’ or funny peculiar?”

Did it make you laugh or was it strange?

If not, use ‘fun’.
