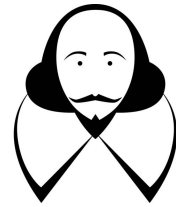


# William Shakespeare Quotes

**Merchant of Venice:** He hath disgraced me: laughed at my losses, mocked at my gains.

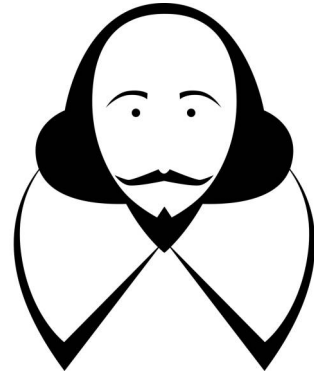
**The Tempest:** We are such stuff as dreams are made on, and our little life is rounded with a sleep.
