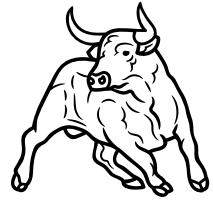

# The Fly And The Bull

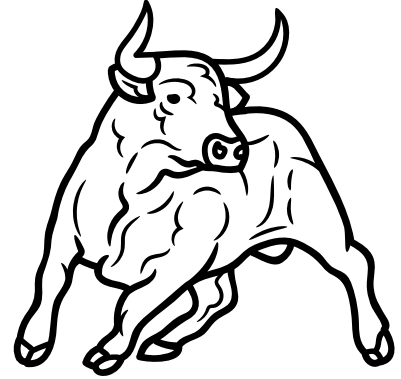
## An Aesop's Fable

"It's all the same to me," replied the Bull. "I didn't even know you were there."

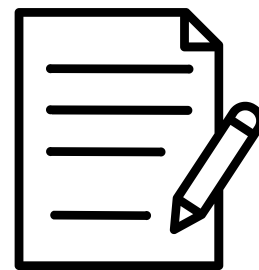
