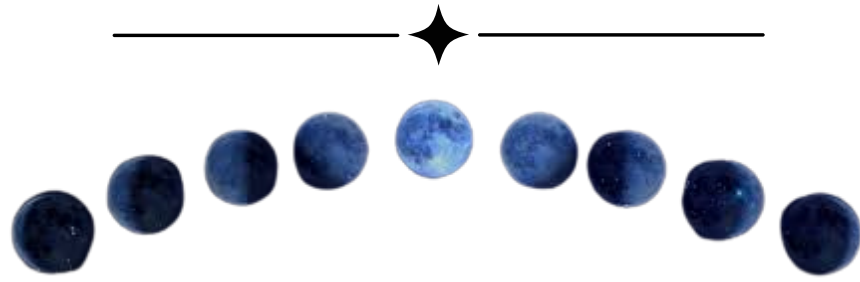


We choose to go to the moon.
